### Julie Naim's garden beds:

#### Brassica bed # 1 – salad type

mizuna (SESE); yukina savoy (WF); maruba santoh (WF); and hon tsai tai (WF)

#### Brassica Bed # 2 – cooking type

Feaster family heirloom mustard (WF); Ethiopian kale (WF); Georgia southern collards (WF); perennial grex kale (EFN); Easter egg radishes (SESE)

#### Amaranthaceae bed (all SESE)

ruby red chard; early wonder beets; calendula

#### Asteraceae & Allium bed

red salad bowl lettuce (SESE); French red shallots (STS); French red garlic (STS); shungiku chrysanthemum (WF)

#### Legume & Apiaceae bed

Danvers 126 carrots (SESE); sugar Ann peas 2 ft (SESE); sugar snap peas 6 ft (WF)

WF=Working Food / SESE=Southern Exposure Seed Exchange / EFN=Experimental Farm Network / STS=Sow True Seeds
